

Alturas Health and Safety Protocol and Screening for COVID-19

Alturas looks forward to seeing our clients, suppliers, contractors, and visitors in person soon.

Alturas is now scheduling on-site audits and in-person visits to begin in August 2021. Visitors must contact Alturas for approval at least two weeks prior to their on-site visit (or as soon as possible after scheduling the visit). In-person visitors must be fully vaccinated in order to enter the facility. Visitors are required to wear a mask while on the premises if they have used a form of shared transportation (flight, train, bus, etc.) or have been in a group setting in the last 10 days.

Alturas will continue to perform virtual audits for those who are not fully vaccinated.

Service providers, while at the Alturas site, must wear a mask while working indoors.

Alturas remains committed to maintaining a safe workplace for our employees and those who visit our site. Because of this, Alturas advises following all CDC guidelines and local and federal regulations regarding COVID-19.

Upon Arrival at the Alturas facility:

- You will be expected to attest to your health and to your willingness to follow Alturas protocols.
- If you have traveled using a form of shared transportation, you will be given a mask upon entry. This must be worn properly and cover your nose and mouth at all times in the Alturas facility.
- Immediately wash your hands each time you enter the facility and continue to frequently wash your hands or use hand sanitizer during your time at the facility.
- Immediately inform Alturas if you develop symptoms of COVID-19 while at the facility.
- Practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from Alturas employees.

At the Alturas facility, we have been operating as usual under precautions while following the CDC's guidance on COVID-19. Alturas guidelines may change according to regional infection rates, guidance by local health departments, ordinances by local government, or guidance by the CDC.

Alturas COVID-19 Attestation:

I have not tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 10 days and am not awaiting COVID-19 test results.

I am not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms listed by the CDC (fever or chills, headache, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste and smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea).
